Cookie Policy

This website uses cookies to better the users experience while visiting All Your Junk Ltd website. Where applicable this website uses a cookie control system allowing the user on their first visit to the website to allow or disallow the use of cookies on their computer / device.

This complies with recent legislation requirements for websites to obtain explicit consent from users before leaving behind or reading files such as cookies on a user's computer / device.

Google Analytics

This is a web analytics service provided by Google enabling us to recognise repeat visitors to the site.

By matching an anonymous, randomly generated identifier, we're able to record specific browsing information such as how you arrive at the site, the pages you view, options you select, and the path you take through the site. By monitoring this information we're able to make improvements to our sites.

Google also reserve the rights to the data collected.

These cookies are used to store information, such as what time your current visit occurred, whether you have been to the site before, and what site referred you to the web page.



These cookies contain no personally identifiable information but they will use your computer's IP address to know from where in the world you are accessing the Internet.

Google stores the information collected by these cookies on servers in the United States. Google may transfer this information to third-parties where required to do so by law, or where such third-parties process the information on Google's behalf.
